

RAINBOW SHUFFLEBOARD

Noah
Genesis 9:1-17

Grade Levels: 1-6

Game Type: Large Motor

Number of Teams: 2 or more teams

Playing Area: Indoors or Outdoors

Equipment or Supplies: Sidewalk chalk (or a poster with a rainbow drawn on it)
1 Bean bag per team

Object of the Game: The team with the most points wins.

DIRECTIONS

Pre-Class Preparation: Using sidewalk chalk, draw a rainbow with six arches on the sidewalk or on a poster. Number each arch. (You may color each arch: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and violet.)

1. Divide the class in two or teams. Give the first player on each team a bean bag. (Be sure they are different colors.)
2. The first player on each team stands at the throwing line and throws the bean bag at the rainbow.
3. The player earns the number of points for his team marked on the arch his bean bag lands in. If the bean bag lands in between two arches, he earns the number of points from the largest arch.
4. The next player on each team stands at the throwing line and throws the bean bag at the rainbow. He earns the number of points marked for his team.
5. Repeat step #4 until all the players have completed the round 3 times.
6. The team with most points wins.
