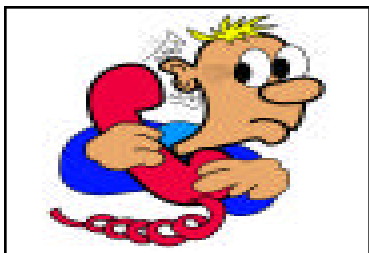


About Learning Styles ...

- Being an auditory, visual or kinesthetic learner does not mean you can't learn in any other mode.
- 30% of children do not have a specific learning style.
- Style can shift, blend or develop as a child gets older.
Generally ...
 - Infants - Kindergarten: Very kinesthetic
 - By Second Grade: Visual skills have developed
 - By Sixth Grade: Auditory skills are strengthened

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE LEARNING STYLES



AUDITORY LEARNER

- Likes to read out loud
- Learns by listening to others or self
(Can't wait to talk!)
- Is easily distracted by sounds
- Learns well with drama & role play

Teaching Suggestions:

- Provide opportunities for kids to listen to oral reading, ask questions, and participate in group discussions
- Always give verbal instructions
