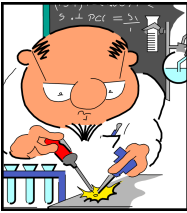


WHY GAMES?

THERE ARE THREE WAYS WE CAN USE GAMES TO TEACH.



- **To discover new information**
Games used to introduce new material to be learned in the lesson
Examples: Bible Bingo, Treasure Hunt

- **To review old information**
Games used to review material covered in the past
Examples: Bible Squares, Bible Bucks



- **To apply information learned**
Games used to actually apply God's truths learned in the lesson
Examples: Who Am I?, Scavenger Hunt
